SITU is an unconventional architecture practice using design, research, and fabrication for creative and social impact. We are seeking a full-time Lead Fabricator for our fabrication division to start immediately.

About the Position

We are currently seeking a mid- to senior-level wood and/or metal worker to join our team. Candidates must be able to lead a team of fabricators in addition to conducting work independently. Candidates who have a strong background in woodworking must be proficient in all woodworking application, and all standard woodworking machinery operations. Most of our projects utilize both CNC cut pieces and handcrafted work, so an awareness of how the two methods can be integrated is important. A strong foundation in traditional woodworking methods employed in cabinetry and millwork is essential. Candidates with a background in metalwork must be proficient in all welding applications with an emphasis on TIG welding of steel, stainless steel, aluminium, bronze, etc. Proficiency with cutting, drilling, and grinding/abrading is required, and experience with custom finishing such as patinas and speciality coatings is a plus. The ideal candidate can lead a team on projects that include multiple materials, exemplifies an eagerness to learn new processes, and is excited to take on projects that require creative problem solving and applying unconventional techniques.

The position requires the following physical abilities:

- Able to lift objects up to 50lbs
- Must be able to work continuously for 2-3 hours standing up

Candidates must be able to read architectural drawings, follow directions from managers, maintain a high level of communication as a team member, and maintain composure during stressful situations.

The position is eligible for overtime, though the typical workweek is 35-40 hours. We offer great benefits, reasonable working hours, and the opportunity to support creative, thoughtful projects in a shop/studio environment. Benefits include options for health, dental, vision, life, and long term disability insurance, One Medical membership, two weeks paid vacation, and other perks such as supplemented CitiBike memberships. After a year of work, you are eligible to contribute to a 401(k) plan through the business, and SITU will match your contributions, dollar for dollar, up to 4% of your annual pay. Compensation is commensurate with experience.
