Overview

As a unique and multi-disciplinary practice, we are seeking a unique and multi-disciplinary teammate to take on the role of Fabricator in our Fabrication division. Working closely with Project managers and Lead Fabricators, this mid level woodworker will be responsible for various fabrication processes within the shop and on jobsites.

Candidates who have a strong background in woodworking must be proficient in all woodworking applications, and all standard woodworking machinery operations. Most of our projects utilize both CNC cut pieces and handcrafted work, so an awareness of how the two methods can be integrated is important. A strong foundation in traditional woodworking methods employed in cabinetry and millwork is essential. The ideal candidate can delegate to less experienced fabricators on projects that include multiple materials, exemplifies an eagerness to learn new processes, and is excited to take on projects that require creative problem solving and applying unconventional techniques.

Since our projects often comprise multiple materials, at times the candidate may be asked to perform fabrication tasks using metal, composites or other materials. The position is full-time (M~F 9AM - 5PM with a 1 hour, unpaid lunch break)

The position requires the following physical abilities:

- Ability to lift objects up to 50lbs to a height of 3-4 feet.
- Ability to work continuously for 2-3 hours standing up.
- Maintain a high level of communication as a team member, and keep cool during stressful situations.

You also need to meet these mandatory requirements:

- Must speak English (ESOL acceptable).
- Have a high school diploma, GED, or equivalent knowledge, skills, experience, or training certification.

Although this position is eligible for overtime, you won't typically work more than 40 hours per week. Compensation is commensurate with experience.

You're probably new to the industry or entering the workforce, and are looking for a company to get excited about in the fabrication, construction, or manufacturing industries. You have a positive, flexible attitude, strong organizational skills, and are a self-starter.

- Ability to read architectural drawings

- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively on teams
